INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND CHAPERONES

Parking in the Kravis Center Garage is free and open to the public. The entrance to the Kravis Center Garage is on S. Tamarind Avenue.

When you arrive at the Kravis Center for the Performing Arts, please stop by the **Greeting Station** in the lobby to pick up a bag from Palm Beach Opera. An updated event map, comfort tools and ear plugs will be included in your bag; you are welcome to bring your own comfort tools. The bag can be used to hold materials that your child may receive at the Education Stations.

You will be given a performance program which discusses the plot of the opera, provides biographical info about the cast, and includes activities to engage young learners.

From the time you arrive to the time you leave, you are welcome to use the Break Space. **The Break Space** offers a quiet retreat where you can sit, lie down, move around without crowds, eat and/or drink –whatever may be needed.

We may not be able to let you into the theater space prior to theater doors opening at 12:30pm; the singers and crew will prepare for the performance up to the 12:30pm time. We encourage you to access to our Pre-Visit Video so that you can see the theater space prior to your trip.

Although the singers will not be amplified during the performance, a narrator WILL use a microphone for English narration throughout the opera. You will be provided a timeline to help identify when the microphone will be used. Likewise, timing for any loud or unexpected noises will be notated on the timeline so that you are not surprised or startled.

During the performance, the lights will be dim rather than fully darkened.

At any point during the performance, you may exit and enter the theater space without worry.

Children's Performance is full of kids of all ages, many of whom love to shout out with glee, clap their hands, laugh loudly and scream "Bravo" to the opera singers! Please feel free to join in as there is no need to keep quiet at this event!

At the end of the performance, there will be a surge of movement as everyone attempts to exit the theater and head to 1) the lobby for Artist Autographs or 2) to the parking garage. If you would like to leave prior to the end of the performance, please feel free to do so. The timeline will let you know a good time to exit to avoid moving through the large crowd. Artist autographs will be provided in your child's bag from PBO.
